The Stockholm Criminology Symposium is an annual event, which attracts some 500 attendees from all over the world. During its fifteen year long existence the Symposium has become one of Europe's most influential meeting points for researchers, policy-makers and practitioners.

The conference offers three days filled with a large number of presentations of international projects, programs, academic research as well as studies and inquiries conducted by public sector agencies. The Symposium is organized by the Swedish National Council of Crime Prevention on behalf of the Swedish Government.

Theme 2020: Gun violence – Sound Knowledge and Countermeasures

There is a pressing need to gather and discuss research, policy, and practice relating to gun violence and how it may be combated, which constitutes the aim of this year's main theme "Gun violence: sound knowledge and countermeasures". The theme will include presentations on a variety of approaches, results, and experiences from all around the world.

The 2020 Stockholm Prize in Criminology has been awarded to Philip J. Cook and Franklin E. Zimring for their research in evidence-based explanations of gun policy effects. The winners will receive the Prize during the Award Ceremony and Dinner in Stockholm City Hall on the evening of June 10.
