1. Agenda – Budget Proposal 2023, Research Grants and Research Seminar 2023, Revision of the Evaluation Template for Researcher Projects and New Members of the Council

The Executive Secretary presented the budget proposal for 2023. Of note was extra expenses due to change of publisher and making the journal open access. The Council had no comments on the suggested budget, which is to be revisited at the annual Council meeting, which in 2023 will be in Oslo, March 13-14th.

Council member Erik Grevholm had sent in suggestions for improving the evaluation template for research project following up on discussion at the Council Meeting in Stockholm. The Council unanimously approved of the suggested changes.

The Chair Heidi Mork Lomell informed the Council of the deadlines for this year's research application process as well as together with Council member Minna Piispa, about the Research seminar to be hosted in Finland.

Council member Minna Piispa and Council member Erik Grevholm informed that there will be appointed new members of the Council to replace respectively Caroline Mellgren from Sweden and Natalia Ollus from Finland.

The Secretary asked that the two would be appointed prior to the evaluation process for the 2023 Research Projects.
